## **STAY SAFE MEASURES**



Do not enter our venues if you have tested positive for Covid-19 and follow the current guidance in relation to testing/isolation



Continue encouraging and practising good hand hygiene



Continue following our entry/exit procedures and any one way systems/ directional arrows in place at our venues - this helps us to manage crowding



Face coverings are no longer compulsory but you are welcome to wear one inside our venues if you would like to

## COVID-19: GENERAL OPERATING POLICY.



As of April 2022, all Covid-19 related compulsory rules have been lifted in Scotland however the Scotlish Government recommend exercising ongoing caution in relation to Covid-19 whilst the virus remains prevalent. With this, we will continue to operate as follows:

- Students should arrive as close to their class start time as possible and wait at the venue entrance until called in by a staff member. Note that adults aren't permitted inside our venues to wait during classes - this is to allow us to continue managing safe venue capacities/airflow
- All students being collected by a parent must be collected on time from the designated exit point, which may be in a different location from the entry point
- Students should come to class with an additional layer as we will continue to open windows inside our venues where applicable to enable sufficient airflow
- Face coverings are no longer compulsory Scottish Government recommend wearing a face covering in smaller/busier public areas but this is at the discretion of the wearer - this includes students and SSD staff
- Everyone should follow the current government/NHS guidelines in relation to testing and isolation and continue exercising caution to minimise the spread of Covid-19 and to safeguard other students and SSD staff. We may share information as necessary should positive Covid-19 cases occur at our venues. Our Privacy Policy, viewable on our website, outlines how only necessary data will be shared (e.g. with Test & Protect)
- We will continue to enforce an enhanced cleaning regime at SSDHQ and will also encourage students to practise good hygiene measures across all venues - this means that we will continue to offer hand sanitiser at all our venues and will also clean touch points regularly where appropriate
- We have risk assessed our venues appropriately in relation to Covid-19 to ensure any risks are mitigated accordingly we regularly update these as a matter of good practice

We will continue to follow official Government guidance and review this policy/update our measures as and when required. This policy is viewable at any time via our website.
