## Taking care of your Sewer network in your area.

## What we are doing

We are taking care of the sewer network in your area by upgrading the combined sewer overflow (CSO) to help improve the environment of the Water of Leith. This project forms part of a large investment along the river which will prevent items such as rags, baby wipes and plastic cotton buds from overflowing and polluting the Water of Leith during storm events. Details of the work area can be found over the page.

When are we doing it

Work is due to start on Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2023 and will last approx. 8 months.

## What happens next

- There will be some roadworks during the works, with the use of temporary traffic lights, pedestrian crossings and some access and parking restrictions. **Please follow all signs in place**.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained to Simon Says Dance via the ramp off Inglis
  Green Road next to The Village Inn where a pedestrian crossing will be in place.
- Vehicular access to KD Motors, Matthews Foods and Imperial Palace will be maintained by 3-way traffic lights.
- There will be some disruption from construction traffic and noise during the works, however our contractor will do all they can to keep this to a minimum.
- There will be no disruption to water or wastewater services during these works.
